Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year from Kier and SPFT



Since our last update, we have completed a deep excavation to the south west of site which means we have been able to lay the slabs that mark out the footprint for the southern-most hospital ward, the first of three.

We will now be starting works on drainage and foundations at the westernmost point of site - as well as drying out the subsoil to the north.

Looking forward, we will start to put up the steel frame for the building during February. This work will be carried out by mobile crane, with cherry pickers, which will enter the site using the new track being created around the site perimeter.

We will be stopping work on site between Saturday 23 December to Tuesday 2 January. We can reassure you that during this time, the site will be monitored constantly, both remotely and by physical visits.

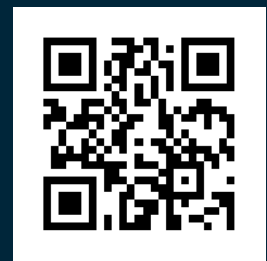
