





Protecting communities against flooding: Mansfield SuDS

Working on behalf of Severn Trent, we have helped build the UK's largest retrofit sustainable drainage system (SuDS), designed to tackle the growing challenge of extreme rainfall events, increasingly common due to climate change.

This network of green infrastructure reduces flood risk to 90,000 people, prevents localised flooding and reduces pressure on combined sewer systems, helping to avoid overflows and drains to cope.

The new features have also created nature-rich, accessible green spaces that improve biodiversity and provide attractive areas for communities to enjoy, demonstrating how climate adaptation, infrastructure resilience, and community wellbeing can be delivered hand in hand.



We are delivering a bridge renewal scheme for National Highways along a six-mile stretch of the M6 between junctions 37 and 38. As part of our Professional Services Alliance (PSA) with Tony Gee and RPS, a Tetra Tech company, we are delivering the design works for the project, which includes 8 structures that are coming to the end of their serviceable life. The works being delivered include permanent and temporary works design.

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2027, with completion expected by winter 2031.



Opened by Her Majesty The Queen, this state-ofthe-art school is one of the first in London to be designed to Passihvaus standards, creating a low carbon building and a healthy environment for the school and local community.

Royal Navy Air Station: Culdrose

RNAS Culdrose is an integral part to the UK's defence. Royal Navy personnel based here include Merlin Helicopter Force, which patrols UK waters and protects the country's nuclear submarine deterrent and aircraft carrier strike groups from threats in the air, on the surface and below the water.

The project at RNAS Culdrose will see the helicopter force's Engineering Training School replaced with a new training hub to ensure personnel have the best facilities to learn how to maintain this vital fleet of Merlin Mk 2 helicopters.

One of the helicopter squadrons, 820 Naval Air Squadron, will also have a brand-new hangar built, its headquarters building upgraded and two additional hangars on the site revamped.





Delivering Central London's biggest SuDS: Joe Strummer Subway

Together with Transport for London (TfL), Westminster Council, Marble Arch BID and Thames Water, Tarmac Kier Joint Venture (TKJV) designed and built central London's largest sustainable urban drainage system (SuDS) at the Joe Strummer Subway, enhancing resilience to climate change and reducing flooding risk.

The new rain gardens at the subway collect and store around 222,000 litres of rainwater, reducing the risk of flooding and sewer overflow. The green infrastructure has provided a safer area for the community, enhanced biodiversity and improved air quality, as well as surface water drainage.







Our rail capability delivers complex, multi-disciplinary infrastructure projects across the UK. It combines our in-house expertise in design, civil engineering, structures, stations, permanent way enhancements, access for all schemes, power, signalling, and telecommunications.

Our integrated approach enables us to deliver high-quality, cost-effective solutions that meet the evolving needs of our clients and communities. From electrification schemes to station upgrades, we're helping shape a more sustainable, accessible rail network.

The team replaced outdated glazing with robust, modern alternatives and reinstated glass directly above the tracks, significantly improving shelter and user experience.

Kier delivers essential water infrastructure across the UK, combining national coverage with innovative, end-to-end solutions. We provide reactive maintenance and major capital upgrades to treatment works, canals, reservoirs, pipelines, pumping stations, sustainable drainage solutions (SuDS), and flood and coastal risk management schemes. We enhance resilience, drive sustainability, and support the UK's long-term water security.

In partnership with the Environment Agency, we are trialling a zero-emission power solution, combining solar panels, green hydrogen fuel cells, and batteries to power our site compound.

We've already applied valuable learnings from planning, setup, and real-time monitoring. This includes adding a second fuel cell and sharing live energy usage data to encourage awareness and behavioural change on site.



Nuclear



We deliver complex infrastructure across the UK's energy and defence nuclear sectors. Our work spans nuclear new build projects, advanced modular and fusion technologies, and secure facilities for the UK's defence capability.

We also enable the safe management and decommissioning of nuclear materials. With proven expertise across all markets, we are helping to shape a cleaner, safer and more resilient nuclear future.





The Kier Property and Vistry Joint Venture will deliver 343 new mixed-tenure homes in South Wokingham as part of a larger development of 1,434 homes. The overall consortium project, which involves Miller Homes includes 35% affordable housing and 65% private sale homes, a primary school, public spaces and a local centre.

Construction is set to begin later this year with the development aiming to create a sustainable, vibrant community with strong transport links.





Watford Riverwell is a £500m GDV, 70-acre urban regeneration scheme on the edge of Watford town centre, delivered through a 50:50 JV between Kier Property and Watford Borough Council.

To date 579 homes, including affordable homes, have been delivered together with a retirement village, a Trade City industrial employment scheme, a 1,455-space hospital multi-storey car park and other major infrastructure works.

Current phases include a new public square with a 131-bedroom Travelodge, Tesco and Greggs and a pre-let Safestore unit targeting BREEAM Excellent. Avenues Phase Two will deliver a further 110 homes of the 1,100 (total) new homes that will have been delivered at the end of the JV, continuing its vision for a vibrant, sustainable community where people can live, work and socialise.
