Progress

Since our last update, we have fitted and tested the first specialist joinery in the bedrooms, and we've carried out what is called the 'first fix' on Ward 1. This is the vital work that happens after the foundations and roof are in place, but before any plastering takes place, such as the pipe and electrical installations.

Inside, we are finishing partitions and internal blockwork including the lift shaft. Outside, we're completing the brickwork and roofing all over the building as well as installing the final cladding, starting at the southernmost end of the building.

We are also preparing to pull all the electrical distribution cables into the building.

We are coming up to quarter of a million man-hours worked on site, with no signs of slowing up. The deliveries of materials will also increase as we reach peak activity.
