- Welfare Area relocated December 2023 to north-east corner of site
- Hoarding along The Highway A1203 will start partially being dismantled from mid January 2024
- Tower Crane will be dismantled 1st quarter 2024
- Brick party wall along pedestrian footpath South elevation has started January 2024
