On Thursday 5 October, we held a public meeting for local people at The Pelham community hub in Holliers Hill.

More than 30 of you attended and we responded to a wide range of questions about the development. One particular area of interest was the proposed secondary emergency access into the site. We let people know that our preferred option is to create a second entrance in Mount View Street and the access will run round the outside edge of the site.

This has not been confirmed yet as we still need the relevant permissions from Rother District. We will keep you posted on progress.

Community activity

We visited Ore Valley College in Hastings recently to talk to students about construction apprenticeship opportunities. This visit was well received.

We are continuing to liaise with Rother District Council about our *Local Employment and Skills Plan* which needs to be implemented as part of the planning permission for the development
