Hello, I'm your Senior Project Manager and I wanted to share with you the latest news on the project we are delivering for the local community.

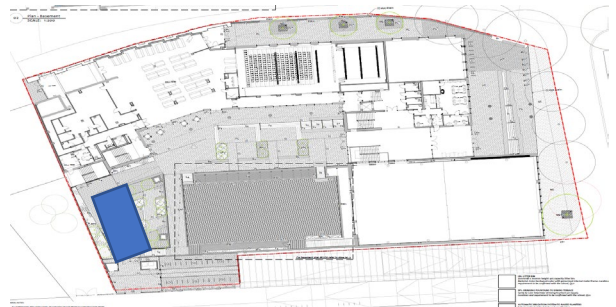
Here, you will find an update on what we have been doing over the past months as well as how we have been engaging with the local community.

An update on your project

- Our concrete frame structure is getting erected and we completed the 1st part of the ground floor slab on 23rd/08
- We are finishing our excavation and foundation works (south east corner)
- Pennington street will close during 14th–18th November 2022 for St George works
- We attended the Mulberry Trust Evening with future parents on 04th/10 where we discussed details of the school in more depth
- Our project will propose 2 *Open Door* days to the public around mid-March (details to follow shortly)
- The site will be shut for Christmas break from Friday 23rd/12/2022 at 18.00 and will re-open on Tuesday 03rd/01/2023 at 08.00
- The new welfare accommodation (south west corner of the site) will be installed on 21st and 22nd December 2022
- Steel work will start on 9th January 2023
